Robert Quinn is responsible for management of regulatory matters at the Federal Communications Commission, as well as the coordination and support of regulatory and external affairs activities throughout AT&T's regional operations. He was appointed to his current position in February 2006. Previously he served as Vice President, Federal Regulatory Affairs for AT&T in Washington, DC, where he represented AT&T before the Federal Communications Commission and the United States Department of Justice since 1997. Prior to that he served as senior regional attorney for AT&T in Chicago, Illinois, representing AT&T before various state public utilities commissions in the Midwest. Prior to joining AT&T, Quinn spent five years as a trial litigator with the Chicago firm Mayer, Brown & Platt (now Mayer, Brown, Rowe and Maw).

An Illinois native, Quinn graduated from the University of Illinois with a bachelor's degree in English. He also received his J.D. with Honors from DePaul University in Chicago where he served as Managing Editor of Lead Articles for the DePaul Law Review.
