It is always a pleasure and special privilege for me to be here with my fellow broadcast pioneers to participate in this significant Golden Mike Award Ceremony and a special pleasure today to recognize WPIX-TV, a distinguished Tribune station.

Once again, it is a pleasure to present the Tribune Company with a true copy of the original FCC license for WPIX-TV, a distinguished pioneer station. I also want to recognize the Tribune's overall record of distinguished service in both TV and radio.

My heartiest congratulations. It is particularly pleasing that this pioneer station is in such responsible hands. The heritage of quality, integrity and responsibility in programming and management is being updated and further strengthened today.
