In re: Notice of Proposed Rule Making to amend Part 15 of the Commission's Rules concerning the use of low power radio devices for providing communications services for handicapped persons

While we generally support the proposal to reduce restrictions on the use of auditory training devices, we do have some concerns about the use of specific frequencies immediately adjacent to the AM broadcast band with increased power levels. The potential for interference to AM broadcasting through widespread use of those frequencies and power levels would seem to be significant. Thus, the burden to be borne by those advocating such usage, in our views, will be significant.

Therefore, we concur.
