CONCURRING STATEMENT OF FCC COMMISSIONER JAMES H. QUELLO

In Re: Petition for Reconsideration in the Belo Broadcasting Corporation/Maxwell Broadcasting Corporation comparative renewal proceeding (Docket Nos. 20945-48).

I concur in this decision to remand because it appears to be required by the policy we announced in <u>George H. Cameron Jr.</u> <u>Communications</u>, 71 FCC 2d 460 (1979). I am now concerned, however, that full implementation of the <u>Cameron</u> policy, plus its extension into areas outside the renewal context, <u>1</u>/ may cause procedural and substantive problems which were not immediately apparent. I look forward to a thoughtful reexamination of the <u>Cameron</u> policy, but I concur here because this reexamination may best be conducted outside the context of an individual proceeding.
