

DISSENTING STATEMENT OF
COMMISSIONER HENRY M. RIVERA

IN WHICH COMMISSIONER JAMES H. QUELLO JOINS

RE: Reconsideration of Dismissal of Waiver Petition filed by the Sanyo Manufacturing Corporation concerning manufacturing of a "Specific Signal Display Device"

I again dissent 1/ to the Commission's failure to abide by Section 303(s) of the Communications Act and its own rules. 2/ I am more convinced now than when we first acted that the majority's decision is in error -- in fact, while six petitioners sought reconsideration of this decision, not one party, not even the original petitioner, has expressed continued support for this waiver request.
