Separate Statement of Commissioner Patricia Diaz Dennis In Which Commissioner James H. Quello Joins

In Re: Application of Bill Welch For Commission Consent to Transfer Control of the Florence, Alabama Non-Wireline Cellular Permit to McCaw Communications of Florence, Inc.

My support for this item is premised on the particular circumstances of the cellular industry at this point in time. Because extensive construction has already been completed in the larger markets, this ruling will generally affect only those smaller cellular markets now under construction or awaiting Commission selection of a permittee.

In smaller cellular markets, this ruling should ultimately benefit the public by speeding the availability of cellular service. It will undoubtedly facilitate the fusion of these smaller markets with adjacent existing cellular facilities when the permittee finds it uneconomic to operate a stand-alone system. The economics of smaller markets dictate that expanding an existing system to include an adjacent unbuilt market may, in many cases, provide service more efficiently and quickly. Only because of <u>these</u> particular circumstances in <u>this</u> particular industry do I accept the for-profit sale of construction permits as being in the public interest.

No one should interpret this common carrier decision as a precedent for allowing the sale of a construction permit for profit in the broadcasting industry.
