

STATEMENT OF COMMISSIONER JAMES H. QUELLO
CONCURRING IN PART AND DISSENTING IN PART
IN WHICH COMMISSIONER BENJAMIN L. HOOKS JOINS *
IN RE: DOCKET 19528
APRIL 27, 1976

I have no quarrel with this order insofar as it clarifies our rules with regard to the registration of terminal equipment other than PBX's, key telephone equipment, main telephones and coin telephones. Therefore, I concur with that portion of the order.

My concern continues to be the haste with which we moved to include all terminal equipment absent relevant data bearing on the potential economic impact upon the telephone network and upon the rate-paying public. My dissent to the inclusion at this time of PBX's, key sets, main telephones and coin telephones goes to the substance of that action and not merely to the clarification contained within this order.
