I want to express my personal support for the admirable goals of the Federal Women's Program to promote career development and advancement opportunities for women employed by the Federal government. The values and goals of FEW are consistent with my goals of providing growth opportunities, recognition for achievements and promotions for women.

In my 18 years here at the FCC, I have seen more women moving into higher grade levels and into the Senior Executive Service.
