

CONCURRING STATEMENT OF COMMISSIONER JAMES H. QUELLO

In re: Johnstown Cable TV

I concur with the result reached herein, namely that some 23,000 cable subscribers served by the Johnstown cable complex headquartered in Johnstown will be able to receive the signal of WTTG. However, I do not agree that the application for certificate of compliance permitting addition of this signal should be dismissed and the signal authorized on a special relief basis. I have consistently taken the position that TelePrompTer can and should be issued a certificate of compliance for its Johnstown cable operation, and, accordingly, I believe the application for certificate to add the signal on a permanent basis should have been granted today.
